

In case you receive a NWO-stipend:

Finances and accountability

The total budget will be paid to the Institute at the start of the Visiting Fellowship. The grant does not cover university overhead costs. **The bench fee of the Institute will therefore have to be paid by the visitor him/herself.**

70% of the stipend will be paid to the visitor at the start of the Visiting Fellowship. The Visiting Fellow will have to formally declare to accept INTERVICT's terms of the stipend.

The remaining 30% will be paid after the conclusion of the visit and the receipt of a final report. Please be aware that the University might be obliged by Dutch Tax Authorities to withhold social and security taxes from the stipend. This withhold and the percentage of withhold is depending on the regulations and agreements the Netherlands has with your country of residence.

The Visiting Fellow is required to submit to INTERVICT a final report within three months after his/her departure from the Institute. It should include a summary of activities done, work results and a financial paragraph. The final report is to be no more than 1500 words. INTERVICT will forward the report to NWO.
