
# Major-Minor in Medical Psychology

## **Courses Medical Psychology**

### Sexology

#### Block 2

6 ECTS

In this course you learn about sexuality and sexual development and different contributing factors. You will learn about theoretical and methodological approaches as well as interventions and therapies.

# Clinical Health Psychology in Medical Science

Block 4

6 ECTS

You will learn about psychological aspects of diseases (e.g., coping), the effect of disease on caregivers (partners), as well as physiological principles.

#### Block 3


6 ECTS

This course focuses on stressors and their effects on body and mind. You will learn about what stress is as well as psycho-biological mechanisms and potential interventions.

# Psychological Assessment Block 1

6 ECTS - Only Major

You will learn about the diagnostic cycle that is used in clinical practice. You will learn to analyze the referral question, formulate and test hypotheses about client's condition, and outline recommendations for intervention.
