The Dean, in consultation with the Examining Board, decides per course/program on the most suitable form of testing, whereby quality is paramount.				
	Independent study places	Independent workplaces are available with priority for specific groups of students; booking required. From Nov. 7 also available in the Library on weekends.				On working days limited number of workplaces for specific groups of students. Booking required.
	Internships	The rules and protocols of the sector where the internship takes place apply.				
	Exchange	Exchange to countries outside the EEA has been canceled until further notice. Exchange to destinations in EEA countries and exchange from all countries to Tilburg University are continued, unless the exchange is canceled by the partner university or students themselves (e.g., due to travel advice from the relevant government).
