


In accordance with the TiSEM IRB Regulations, the IRB has drawn up an annual report for 2023.


2. Overview submitted and processed proposals 1-1-2023 – 31-12-2023





3. Overview submitted proposals 2020-2023

The IRB has seen a 65% increase in proposals submitted in 2023 compared to the previous year.



The Economics Department has been the most active, with the highest number of proposals in total and per year, except for 2021. The Marketing and Management Departments have also submitted a significant number of proposals, while the Department of Accounting has shown a steady increase in the number of proposals submitted to the IRB since 2020.



4. Review process

New versions of the TiSEM IRB Regulations and Operating Procedure were approved by the IRB on September 26, 2023.
