

ADDENDUM TO THE EDUCATION AND EXAMINATION REGULATIONS 2021-2022 MASTER'S PROGRAMS TSHD

1. Applicability of the Addendum

This addendum is a supplement to the 2021–2022 Education and Examination Regulations (EER) for TSHD Master's degree programs. Where indicated, this addendum replaces the provisions of the 2021–2022 EER.

2. Amendments of Master's program in Philosophy.

Article 4.2 Previous education and admission to the Master's program

Paragraph 2 Current text:

- Master's program in Philosophy: Philosophy of Mind and Psychology:
 - Bachelor's program in Philosophy - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Social Sciences: Human Behavior
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Cognitive Neuroscience: Brain and Cognition
- Master's program in Philosophy: other tracks
 - Bachelor's program in Philosophy
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with a Major Arts and Humanities: Present, Past, Future

Amended to:

- Master's program in Philosophy: Philosophy of Mind and Psychology
 - Bachelor's program in Philosophy
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Social Sciences: Human Behavior
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Cognitive Neuroscience: Brain and Cognition
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Arts and Humanities: Present, Past, Future
- Master's program in Philosophy: Ethics of Business and Organization; Philosophy of Contemporary Challenges; Philosophy of Humanity and Culture
 - Bachelor's program in Philosophy
 - Bachelor's program in Liberal Arts and Sciences with the Major Arts and Humanities: Present, Past, Future

3. Implication modification.

This change from the current text in the 2021–2022 EER implies that students with a completed Bachelor's program LAS with the Major Social Sciences: Human Behavior, Cognitive; Neuroscience: Brain and Cognition or Arts; and Humanities: Present, Past, Future are admissible to the Master's program in Philosophy: Philosophy of Mind and Psychology.

Students with a completed Bachelor's program LAS with the Major Arts and Humanities: Present, Past, Future are admitted to all tracks in the Philosophy Master's program.

4. Amendments to the Master's programs in Data Science and Society.

880502-M-18 Master's thesis/Data Science in Action admission requirements (PART 2, page 30)

Current text:

24 ECTS i.e., 12 ECTS of mandatory courses + 2 Research Skills courses + 1 elective course of the chosen track.

Amended text:

24 ECTS: 12 ECTS from mandatory courses, 6 ECTS from Research Skills courses, and 6 ECTS from other courses in the DSS curriculum.

5. Amendment of Master's program in Culture Studies.

An additional elective course has been added to the Master's program Culture Studies:

- M KCW: Art and Media Studies
- M KCW: Digital Culture Studies
- M KCW: Management of Cultural Diversity
