Title: Toward inclusive education practices in post-secondary education

The goal of inclusive education is to ensure that all students can receive equal access to quality education. The current university campus holds students with diverse backgrounds such as various physical and mental health conditions, cultural and/or religious backgrounds, and cognitive abilities. The transition from high school to post-secondary education is challenging to many students, especially if their backgrounds are not mainstream. In this talk, I will focus on inclusive education for the post-secondary setting. I will discuss inclusive education practices implemented in University of Calgary in Canada, and the Burkhart Center for Autism Education and Research in the United States. I will conclude my presentation by discussing the latest findings from our research group.
