

Overview of courses for the purpose of enrolment in Master's program in HRS 2021/2022

It is used to test whether sufficient knowledge of HRM and research methods and techniques has been gained during the preparatory training to be able to successfully complete the HRS Master's program. The list you submit will then be assessed by the Examination Board Social Sciences TSB. The course list consists of 8 (sub) disciplines. For each discipline, the course as offered in the Bachelor's program in Human Resource Studies is shown as an example.
