**Transition Rules Skills lab 1 2020-2021**

As of the 2021-2022 academic year the setup of the Skills lab 1 course has changed. As a result, the following transition rules will enable those that failed the course in 2020-2021 to complete their Skills lab 1 course in the first semester of the 2021-2022 academic year.

If you failed to successfully complete the Skills lab 1 course (including PASS) you can opt to follow and complete the new course setup, or to remediate the course in the setup as you followed it last year.



If you failed the Skills lab 1 course you **MUST** inform us **BEFORE** September 6th which of the two options you opt for. For that you can reply to the email you received for this matter and indicate your choice.

If can opt to participate in the new course setup of Skillslab1 as provided in the 2021-2022 academic year, or

If you **opt for remediating** the course as it was provided in the 2020-2021 academic year then:

1. You must obtain at least 6 PASS Points

When you started your E&BI program, PASS was a required component of your Skills Lab 1 course. During that course you had to accrue at least 6 PASS points to be able to pass the Skills Lab 1 course. You can only complete the course if you obtain enough PASS points. In case you have accrued insufficient PASS points then the following transition rules apply:

In case you failed the course due to (at least) an insufficient number of PASS points that you obtained in the first and second semester, you will need to remediate this by obtaining additional PASS points to meet the minimum of 6 PASS points.

For the coming year, PASS will no longer be part of the Skills lab 1 course but continue as a separate course. That is why you must obtain enough pass points in the 2021-2022 academic year to successfully complete Skills Lab 1.

I strongly recommend you complete the remediating assignments as soon as possible. If you logon to the Skills Lab 1 canvas page you will find that we have created a new module: Intake 2020-2021: Remediating insufficient PASS points.

Successfully completing that module should allow you to obtain sufficient PASS points.

You are to follow the steps and instructions for that module. At the end you will be provided the option to complete and submit one or two assignments (Remediating PASS 1 and Remediating PASS 2). For each assignment you can obtain 3 PASS points. If you need to **obtain 3 PASS points (or less)**, then you will have to **only complete the Remediating PASS 1 assignment**. If you need to obtain **more than 3 PASS** points then you will have to complete **both** assignments.

Remediating PASS 1

Interview a Tilburg University alumnus who has started and grown a scale-up (10 FTE employees) to learn how that alumnus studied for success. Compare that approach to how you studied in your first year of the E&BI program. Conclude with lessons learned and implications for how you will study in the 2021-2022 academic year. Write this up in a 6 page essay (using APA style 7). Please ensure to attach a Declaration of originality. Rest assured that we will scan your submissions for plagiarism.

## Remediating PASS 2

Identify three empirical research papers that link academic achievement (academic degrees and/or grades obtained) to success in starting and growing entrepreneurial (business) ventures. Use the findings of those papers to present your own theory of academic achievement based venturing success. Conclude with implications for academics (for further research projects), for practitioners (for example investors or policy makers), and for yourself. Write this up in a 6 page essay (using APA style 7). Please ensure to attach a Declaration of originality. Rest assured that we will scan your submissions for plagiarism.

**The deadline to remediate your lacking PASS points is November 15th at 13:00 CET.**

2. You must obtain at least a 5.5 for each of the 4 Skills lab 1 assignments (as they were used in the 2020-2021 academic year).

For each assignment that you need to remediate we provide the option on the Skills lab 1 canvas page to submit a new attempt. If you logon to the Skills Lab 1 canvas page you will find that we have created a new module: Intake 2020-2021: Remediating graded Skills lab 1 assignments. Please ensure to attach a Declaration of originality. Rest assured that we will scan your submissions for plagiarism.

**The deadline to remediate your course assignment(s) is December 15th at 13:00 CET.**

Assignment results will as usually be communicated through Canvas, the revised course result will as usually be communicated through Osiris.
