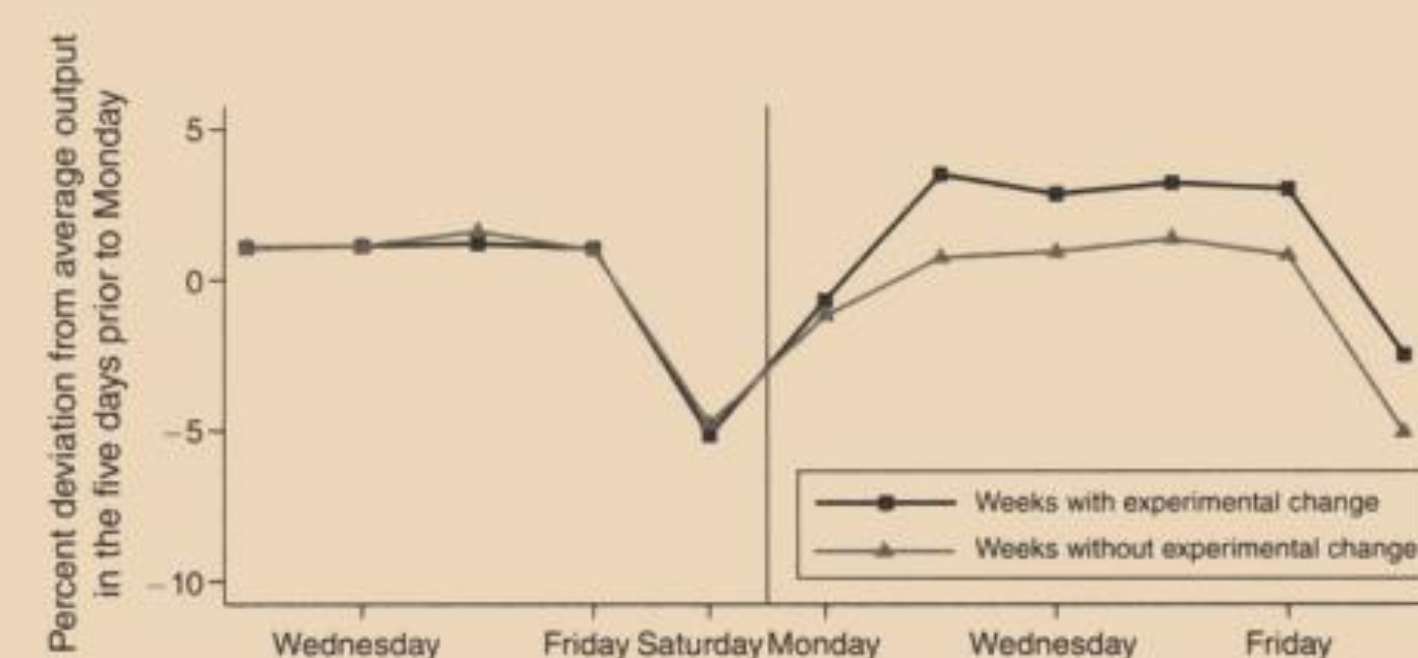
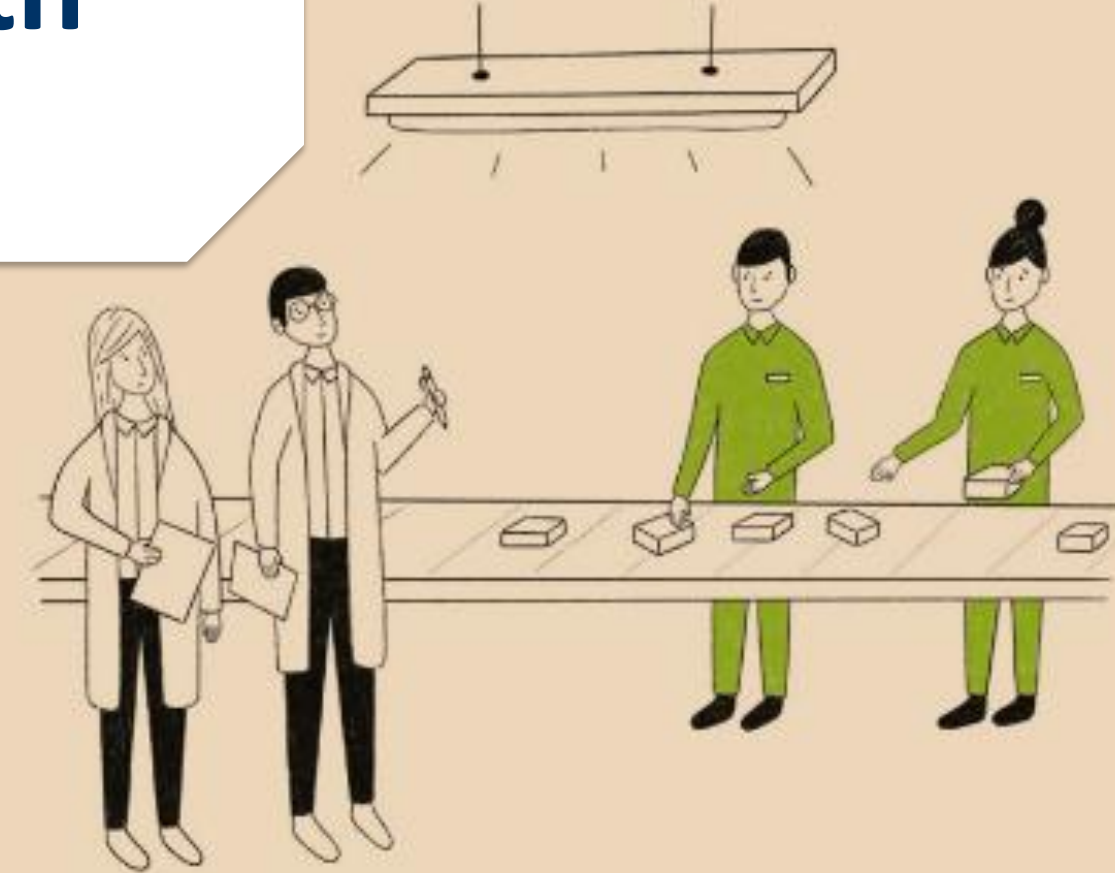


Major-Minor in Clinical Psychology

Introduction

You will acquire essential knowledge, skills, and attitudes that allow you to work effectively as a clinical psychologist in various mental health care settings.



Courses Clinical Psychology

Emotions: Scientific & Clinical Aspects

Block 2

6 ECTS

You will gain insight into emotion and how emotion processes are distorted in mental health conditions. You will learn about theories and studies as well as clinical approaches to target emotions and (dys)regulation.

Personality disorders

Block 3

6 ECTS

You will learn about the epidemiology, etiology, risk factors for onset and maintenance of the most prevalent personality disorders, such as borderline and dependent personality disorder.

Introduction to Treatment Methods

6 ECTS

In this course you will get familiar with theories, principles, techniques of evidence-based therapies. You will also learn about the importance of the therapeutic relationship.

Psychological assessment

Block 1

6 ECTS – Only Major

You will learn about the diagnostic cycle that is used in clinical practice. You will learn to analyze the referral question, formulate and test hypotheses about client's condition, and outline recommendations for intervention.
