

PRIVACY STATEMENT (emergency) contact information third parties/other data subjects

Tilburg University (TiU) considers privacy important and therefore handles your personal data with care. In a number of processes, we process personal data of data subjects who do not have a direct relationship with TiU (so-called 'other data subjects'). In this Privacy Statement, we describe for these processes what happens to your personal data and how your privacy is safeguarded.

1. In which processes do we process personal data of other data subjects?

2. Who is responsible for processing my personal data?

TiU is responsible for the data processing described in this privacy statement. TiU has a statutory duty to ensure that your personal data is processed in accordance with applicable privacy legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

3. Which categories of personal data are processed, for what purpose and on what legal basis?

5. Will my personal data be shared with other parties?

Emergency regarding student

The personal data is securely stored in the student administration application: OSIRIS. OSIRIS is a cloud based solution for student administration, provided by CACI. CACI's servers are located in the Netherlands.

TiU has entered into a data processing agreement with CACI to ensure that your personal data is processed carefully, securely and in accordance with the GDPR. This agreement also stipulates that CACI and its subcontractors (sub-processors) may never process the personal data for their own purposes and may only act in accordance with instructions from TiU.

Emergency regarding employee

The personal data is securely stored in the HR system SAP SuccessFactors. SAP SuccessFactors is a cloud based solution for personnel administration. The servers of SAP SuccesFactors' instances of Tilburg University are located in the Germany.

TiU has made contractual arrangements with SAP to ensure that your personal data is processed carefully, securely and in accordance with the GDPR.

6. Will my personal data be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA)?

Emergency regarding student

No, your personal data stored in Osiris will not be transferred to countries outside the EEA. Only in specific, individual cases, your data might be transferred to another country outside the EEA. You will be informed of such data transfers.

Emergency regarding employee

No, your personal data stored in SAP SuccessFactors will not be transferred to countries outside the EEA. Only in specific, individual cases, your data might be transferred to another country outside the EEA. You will be informed of such data transfers.

7. How long will my personal data be stored?

We determine the retention period based on legislation and regulations. Should you want to have your personal data erased at an earlier stage, this could be done in certain circumstances. Please refer to the privacy statement regarding your rights.



8. Who can I contact if I have questions about the processing of my personal data?

Emergency regarding student

First of all, the student can check and possibly correct your personal data in <u>Osiris Student</u>. Regarding questions about the processing of your personal data, you can contact the <u>Student Desk</u>.

Emergency regarding employee

First of all, the employee can check and possibly correct your personal data in SAP SuccessFactors. Regarding questions about the processing of your personal data, you can contact the <u>HR Service Center</u>..
