- passages from the work of another are paraphrased specification that it concerns
 the opinion or idea of another and without a correct source indication, and/or the
 elaborated ideas or discoveries of another are presented as the student's own
 ideas or discoveries the elaborated ideas or discoveries of another are presented
 as the student's own ideas or discoveries.
- h. In carrying out a research project, manipulating or incorrectly presenting the research results with the intention to mislead.

The following instances, among other things, constitute plagiarism:

- The data used in the study are distorted or fabricated, or irresponsible selection is presented.
- points of view, interpretations, and conclusions of others were intentionally distorted;
- Providing opportunities or encouraging fellow students or examinees to commit fraud;
