

MEMO – DIGITAL DELIVERY PHD THESIS

[MvdP 28-11-2016]

The PhD regulations of 3 October 2016 state in article 21 section 3:

“An electronic version of the thesis shall also be produced, a copy of which shall be supplied to the Library of Tilburg University for publication in the Tilburg University Research Portal. Confidentiality and temporary embargo of the thesis are hereby respected”.

In this memo you read what this means for you.

Why digital delivery?

The reason to make your PhD thesis public digitally is that Tilburg University is of the opinion that everyone should be able to take note of the research conducted by and at the University.

How and what?

The digital version of the PhD thesis must be delivered before the date of the ceremony as one PDF file. You may send the PDF directly to the library via e-mail or you can use the university's Secure FileSender or WeTransfer for very large files.

The version you send should be equal to the final version you also use for the printed version. The plagiarism check and/or possible final changes have already been made at that time.

What happens after delivery?

The digital version of the thesis will be publicly available in the Tilburg University Research Portal shortly after the ceremony. When the full-text has been entered with an embargo, it will be available after expiration of the embargo date.

Embargo

It is possible that the publisher does not allow you to make the PhD thesis or parts of it publicly available, in spite of the request by Tilburg University to do so. In that case you can arrange an embargo period with the publisher. You deliver the full-text to the library according to the described procedure, but it is only made public and freely available in the Research Portal as soon as the embargo period has expired.

Mind that you clearly indicate in your e-mail if the digital version is under embargo! Also indicate when the embargo period expires. A period of half a year to a year is acceptable, a period of 2 years or longer is exceptional!

NARCIS

As soon as the full-text is available via the Research Portal, the PhD thesis and the full-text is automatically included in NARCIS, the national science portal. The following URL brings you directly to the NARCIS subset with only PhD theses of all Dutch universities:

Lay Summary

Tilburg University invites the PhD candidate to provide a brief summary to make the results of the PhD research available to a lay audience. This summary will be inserted in the Research Portal as part (abstract) of the thesis and included in the announcement of the promotion at the Tilburg University website. Regarding the Research Portal, you need to enter the summary in Pure (the source system of the portal) by yourself, like all other details of the thesis. You can read more about the promotion of your thesis on the website in the "Instructions for PhD students."

Copyright

Especially ensure to retain your copyright! That way you have much more control on the reach, availability and distribution of your own publication.

Research shows that free digital availability of PhD theses and/or scientific books may have a positive effect on their sale.
